Upon your arrival:

1. Transportation:

The Congress does not organize transportation from the Airport, therefore we suggest that, from the transportation information pdf, you choose the option that suits you best.

5. Weather and Electricity:

October is autumn in Madrid, with temperatures between 10° and 20° C. Surely, it is a perfect opportunity to see the parks of the city wrapped in reddish and ochre shades of colours.

The electric network in Spain operated at 220 volts and 50 hertz, if you come from a country whose electric network has different characteristics, you should use an electric transformer when connecting your devices in order to avoid accidents.
